

2007 WEBER COUNTY FAIR IDOL

RULES AND REGULATIONS

Each entry must consist of: Completed entry form and the appropriate entry fee \$20 in advance and \$25 at time of auditions. Pre registered entries will be able to audition first. Entry fees are NON-REFUNDABLE. Dates to audition are May 30, June 11 and July 10 at 6:00pm. Sign up for date on entry form. Pre-entries must be received by May 29 at 5:00pm. Auditions will be held in the conference room at the Golden Spike Event Center, 1000 North 1200 West, Ogden.

All contestants must present a professional image and reasonable vocal talent. Any entry that is uncooperative, under the influence of drugs and alcohol, uses profanity or displays any actions perceived unacceptable by the Weber County Fair and its representatives, will be disqualified immediately and removed from the premises. No refund will be provided. Non-professional singers ONLY. (Non-professional singers are those who have not performed for a fee or who are not represented by a talent firm, agent or manager.)

Auditions will be a capella. However, for actual performances the entrant will need to bring an instrumental accompaniment track (minus track).

Winners will be selected by a three judge panel (80%) and the audience (20%).

Judges will be judging on:

Singing ability (vocal talent)	50%
Professionalism	20%
Appearance	10%
Audience Votes	20%

The highest overall score wins. Federal, State and local taxes due are the responsibility of the winners receiving prize money. Each contestant must be able to attend the four days of the Weber County Fair, August 8-11. All contestants selected to participate in the Weber County Fair Idol should be prepared with 4 different songs with instrumental accompaniment track for the song they will be singing. No vocals. Instrumental tracks may be submitted in the following forms only: standard CD with accompanying instrumental tracks only. CDG, CD+G, VCD, cassette tapes with accompanying instrumental track only. Each contestant shall use only the equipment provided by the Weber County Fair.

Format of performances:

Auditions, May 30, June 11 and July 10, all beginning at 6:00pm. Call backs (if needed) will be the end of July, (date yet to be determined).

Wednesday, August 8, will be the first performance. All performances will start at 7:00pm and will be on the grandstand stage.

Thursday, August 9, at the beginning on the show, there will be a *number* of contestants excused (*number* will be determined after auditions) and then the second performance will begin.

Friday, August 10, at the beginning on the show, there will be a *number* of contestants excused (*number* will be determined after auditions) and then the third performance will begin.

Saturday, August 11, at the beginning on the show, there will be a *number* of contestants excused (*number* will be determined after auditions) and then the fourth and final performance will begin. After performance, winner will be announced.

All contestants must do their best while performing - also they must do their best to have a great time. Contestants that do not adhere to this rule shall be subject to going home grumpy!
